# RED CROSS SURGEON DEAD

**Dr. James F. Donnelly**, of New York, Dies in Servia.

Paris, Feb. 25. **Dr. James F. Donnelly**, of New York, a surgeon with the American Red Cross expedition sent to Servia, died yesterday at Nish, according to a dispatch to the Havas Agency. The body will be sent to the United States by way of Salonica.

**Dr. Donnelly** was a graduate of the University of Louisville. He served in New York and Louisville hospitals and held a royal medical degree in Holland. Last June he married the divorced wife of Captain Giles Bishop, who was Miss Florence May Kellerman, of Philadelphia.
